- Begin implementation phase
- Establish competency in your facility
- Establish protocols
- Reduce the need for confirmatory chest X-ray

# Introduction

---

## Implementation phase:

- Precepting
- Clinical Specialist will help develop implementation education at your facility
  - Train the trainer
  - Select 1-2 clinicians to begin education
  - Full focus is required during this time
  - Preceptor will oversee and advise clinicians
  - Preceptor will also observe trainer educate clinicians

## Competency:

- Standardized requirement for independence
- Documentation

## Protocols:

- Collaboration required for success
- Include various departments
  - Administration
  - Radiology
  - Materials Management
  - Director of Nursing

# Introduction

---

## Eliminate chest X-ray:

- During implementation, it is not necessary to correlate with chest X-ray
- If correlation is necessary, as determined by your facility:
  - Choose number of cases, best practice is 10 cases or less
  - Understand radiographic variables (discussed in next module)
  - Include Radiologist in discussion
